To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$29,500.00 in the General Fund of the Human Services Childcare Salary and Wages Account (\$25,000.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$4,500.00). The Morse School Improvement Council has requested the re-opening of the licensed School-Age Childcare Program when the school relocates back to the new building in January 1999. This program was closed during renovations. Revenue will be funded by childcare tuition and will support the cost of a head teacher, an assistant teacher, supplies and start-up costs.
