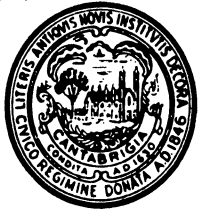

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 32, regarding sidewalks at 10-14 Remington Street, Public Works Commissioner Ralph E. Dunphy reports the following:

Remington Street is scheduled for FY96 sidewalk work following completion of sewer separation work. At that time, sidewalks in need of repair will be replaced with existing materials. If the existing material is asphalt or concrete, it will be replaced with concrete. If a homeowner has asphalt or concrete and wants brick, the homeowner will be charged the difference.

In the case of 10-14 Remington Street, the existing material is asphalt over concrete so the installation of brick would require payment of the difference by the property owner. All brick sidewalks will be installed on a concrete base.
