It is my recommendation to install 1-1000 lumen light on pole at 118 Sciarappa Street.

At present there is a 2500 lumen lamp at the corner of Hurley and Fourth Streets, also at Charles and Fourth Streets, primarily to light Hurley and Charles Streets, although some of the light reaches Fourth Street. The addition of the 1000 lumen light in between will correct this situation.

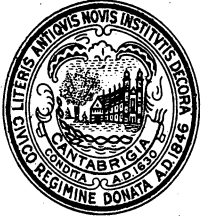


