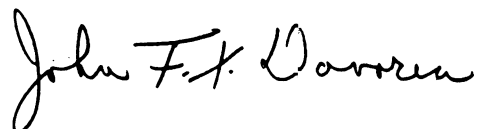

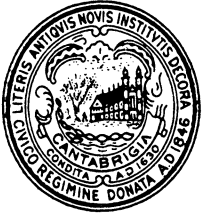

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To provide information regarding international affairs, to promote a greater understanding of the United States's role in world affairs, to promote, improve, and develop the education of all individuals, especially Harvard University undergraduates, by any appropriate means, including (i) sponsorship of conferences, meetings, and colloquia exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as the same may be amended from time to time; (ii) sponsorship of an annual ~~Model United Nations for the purpose of~~ convention of college students known as the Harvard National Model United Nations, for the purpose of educating the attending college students in matters relating to United Nations through the experience of model United Nations sessions and through speakers on international relations; (iii) sponsorship of an annual convention of high school students known as the Harvard Model United Nations, for the purpose of educating the attending high school students in matters relating to to the United Nations through the experience of model United Nations sessions and through speakers on international relations; sponsorship of periodic meetings and seminars dealing with international law and international relations, encouragement ~~of the study of international relations and the promotion of international peace and understanding~~

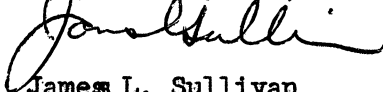
