

# City of Cambridge

The Cambridge City Council, to which was referred the re-zoning petition of Mrs. John C. Vincent et al, conducted a public hearing on Wednesday, February 15, 1978 beginning at 6:52 P. M. in the City Council Chamber. The City Council wishes to submit the following report:

David Vickery, Assistant City Manager for Community Development, presented the Planning Board's favorable recommendation including one amendment.

Speaking in favor of this petition was Ms. Dorothy Rossi, 145 Concord Avenue.

Speaking in opposition of the petition was Mr. Donald Moulton, Assistant Vice President for Community Affairs, Harvard University, who stated that the University was strongly opposed to this petition because it directly relates to the property which the University currently owns and has long-range use plans for this property, and recorded their opposition in writing to the City Clerk.


At this time Mr. Rossi stated that some people within the Observatory Hill area either didn't know about the hearing or were unable to come and requested another hearing be held.
