- WHEREAS: Accessibility to handicapped ramps is extremely important especially during winter months when the ground is covered with snow; and
- WHEREAS: Snow plow operators have difficulty discerning where handicapped ramps are located, and sometimes inadvertently plow them in; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That before the inclement weather is upon us, the P.W.D. make some kind of marking, perhaps a pole, or a sign, that will serve as a guide to snow plow operators, so that handicapped ramps will not be "plowed in" when they are needed most.
