WHEREAS: People have expressed their concern about the neighborhood blight created in the area of Howard Street and Western Avenue by garbage which is either put out on the sidewalk too soon before trash collection, or placed outside without adequate containers; and

WHEREAS: The presence of this trash on the sidewalk and in the street is disturbing to the general well-being of the neighborhood; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to investigate this matter and require that the Department of Public Works take whatever action necessary to rid this neighborhood of this blight; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back within one week regarding whether ticketing will resolve the existing problem.
