

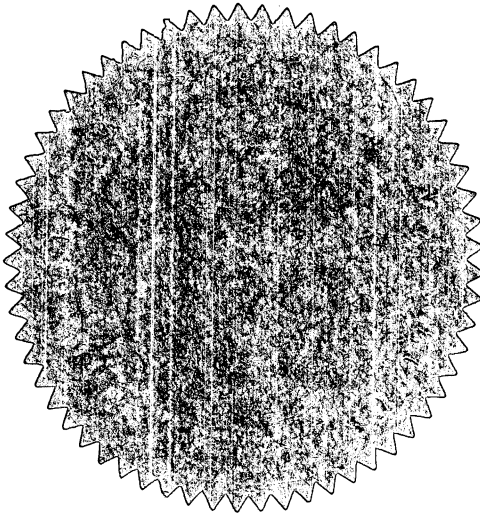

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy^{four}

AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WHICH THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
MAY BORROW FOR PARKING FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 8 of chapter 844 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by striking
out, in line 3, the word "four" and inserting in place thereof the word:-
fifteen.
