Application of TwixTel Technologies, Inc. under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following tariff M.D.P.U. No. 1, Table of Contents, Original Pages 1 through 26, inclusive, filed with the Department on November 8, 1990 to become effective December 8, 1990 by Twixtel Technologies, Inc.
