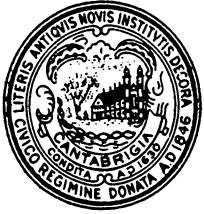
I will notify you of any progress I make with the MDC toward solving this traffic problem.

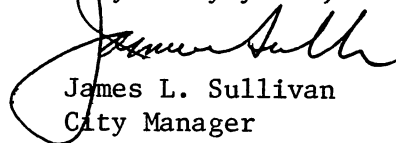
