- ORDERED: That this report be ready by June 3, 1985 one week before the scheduled public hearing on Huron Avenue.

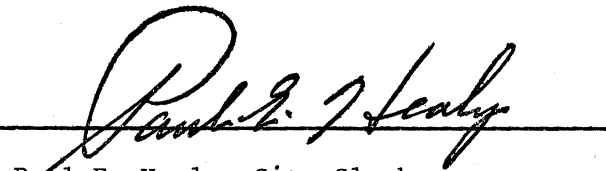
