

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Oct. 30. 1867.

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that Warland Street, so called, should be laid out as a public way - from Pleasant Street to Magazine Street -

Ordered, That said Street be laid out by the name of Warland Street, the same to be forty feet in width, as delineated in a Plan drawn by J. G. Chase, dated Aug. 24, 1867, and now before this Board, the same to be a public Street or way.

Ordered, That no damages be awarded to the owners of the land over which said Warland Street is laid out as aforesaid.
