Dear Sir, I handed down with the
report of Committee on Roads & Bridges,
and accompanying Order, passed by the
New City Council on 14th and 21st May, on
petition of James Cragg & al. for the
acceptance of Donnell St., is, what
purports to be a covenant, waiving notice
and all demands for damages for land
taken by the City for laying out said
Street. Four signatures, by X mark are
unauthenticated, and no acknowledgments
before a Justice of the Peace appears upon
the face of the Covenant. as assuredly should
be done by one signer in behalf of all.

All papers of this kind, I feel sure, should
not only be put in proper form as indicated
above, but after favorable action by the City Council
placed on record at the registry of deeds.
