WHEREAS: Numerous complaints from residents and business people in the Harvard Square area have been received by the City Council relative to the operation of the Metro Bus service which stops in front of the Harvard Sports Bar; and

WHEREAS: These complaints range from toxic fumes which emanate from the bus to the number of times the bus stops in front of the bar to the type of noise which comes from the bus while it is idle waiting to pick up passengers; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the appropriate officials of the Metro Bus service and the Director of Traffic and Parking in order to relocate the stop for this bus from in front of the Harvard Square Sports Bar to another location; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council the action taken by him pursuant to this order within thirty days.
