I will talk with the Police Department concerning the enforcement of this regulation.

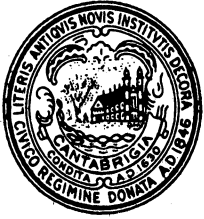

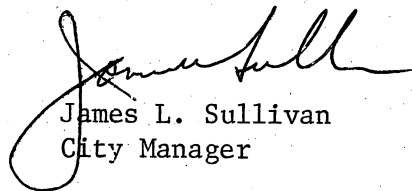
