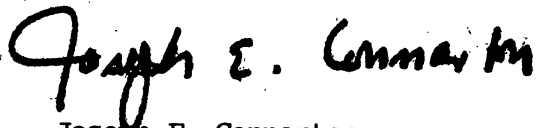

- WHEREAS: There are continuing complaints about bus service on northern Massachusetts Avenue in the area beyond the North Cambridge MBTA yards; and
- WHEREAS These complaints relate to infrequent service and/or busses filled to capacity that do not stop (particularly during rush hour); and
- WHEREAS: It is a public policy goal to provide reliable public transportation to fight automobile traffic problems; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to communicate with the head of the MBTA about the continuing problem with inadequate bus transportation on Massachusetts Avenue north of the MBTA yards; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the head of the MBTA be requested to investigate the causes of this inadequate service and to make corrections in the bus schedule for the Spring; and be it further
- ORDERED: That copies of this resolution be sent to Representative Flaherty and Senator Kraus with request for their assistance.
