- WHEREAS: Father Buckley served as a missionary in Honduras and while serving as a pastor in New York he ministered to both Spanish and English speaking communities; and
- WHEREAS: Father Buckley also served the city by performing the benediction at the School Committee installation in January 2008; now therefore be it
