WHEREAS: Alphonso Carbone of East Cambridge was a member of the Admiral Richard E. Byrd South Pole Expedition II in the 1933-1935 era of polar exploration; and

WHEREAS: Alphonso Carbone together with other brave and fearless men endured many privations and long months away from loved ones in their struggle against the elements in Anartica and under the Southern Cross learned to survive in sub-zero temperatures and opened new frontiers which enabled the United States and the entire world to conquer and harness the adverse forces of nature; now therefore be it
