In Board of Aldermen, *Apr 7* 1886

Ordered.

That, the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to purchase such materials and supplies as shall be necessary to carry on the work of the Street Department during the current year, and without advertising for proposals, therefore as provided by the ordinance approved Dec 16. 1885.

The expense thereof to be charged to the proper appropriations, and to be within the amount heretofore authorized upon said appropriation.

Provided, that the amount of any one purchase, under this order shall not exceed the sum of Three Hundred Dollars.

Referred to the City Solicitor for his Opinion as to the power of the Committee in relation to such purchases when the sum expended is less than Three Hundred Dollars.
