ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to immediately appoint a Blue Ribbon Committee for the sole purpose of examining the needs of Cambridge residents for long-term health care services as well as to describe needed changes or additions in services provided by private or non-profit agencies so that they may meet their service obligations more completely; and be it further

ORDERED: That in conjunction with this committee, the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Administrator of the Neville Manor and the Director of the Hospital to take the appropriate steps to insure that a comprehensive financial feasibility study is done to determine what the net cost to the taxpayer would be should the City determine to expand its present level of nursing home beds beyond the additional 30 beds to which this City Council has already committed itself; said feasibility study should include these 30 beds; and be it further

ORDERED: That this Blue Ribbon Committee be and hereby is requested to report its findings to this City Council as soon as possible.
