

CHANGES IN THE RENT CONTROL LAW

- (w) "Owner of a building", as used in Section 1(b)(4) of the Removal Permit Ordinance shall mean all owners except multiple owners of a building who, after August 10, 1979, occupy or seek to occupy more than half the units in a building of four or more units, or more than five units in a building of ten or more units, and who are not family members as defined by Regulation 57-01(b)(i). A building occupied in such a way shall be considered a de facto cooperative, the creation of which requires a removal permit.

Regulation 13-01(w) passed by the Rent Control Board on October 14, 1987 by a 4-1 vote. Effective as amended October 15, 1987.
