

City of Cambridge
In the year One thousand eight hundred
and Sixty-six.

An Ordinance
establishing the salary of the City Clerk
and for other purposes.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Section One. From and after the first
Monday in January, 1867, the City Clerk
shall receive an annual salary of two
thousand dollars exclusive of fees estab-
lished by law, which salary shall be
paid in equal quarterly payments, and
shall be in full for all services rendered
by him in his official capacity.

Section Two. From and after the first
Monday in January, 1867, there shall be
allowed and paid to the City Clerk the
sum of one thousand dollars per annum
in equal quarterly payment, the same
to be expended by him for clerical assist-
ance in his office.

Section Three. All Ordinances and
parts of ordinances inconsistent here-
with, are hereby repealed.
