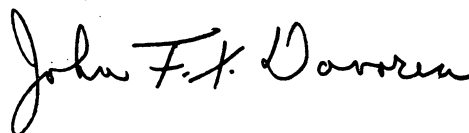

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

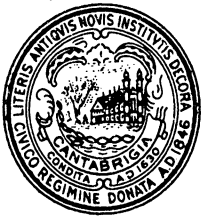
Cambridge Center for Legal Education, Inc.

The aforementioned powers are in furtherance of but not in limitation of the general powers conferred by Chapter 180, as amended, and as further limited by the exempt purposes set forth in Section 501 (c) (3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, as amended.

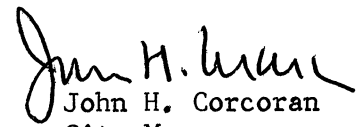
