I have before me three resolutions submitted to your Honorable Body by Mr. John Brode and in turn referred to the writer for report.


The first resolution suggests that the so-called Police Listing be called the Annual Census. I do not know of any objection to this and I plan to make this change.

The second resolution requests the City Solicitor to obtain a legal opinion from the Attorney General and I have requested Mr. Cronin to do so.

The third resolution requests the City Manager to proceed immediately to take all steps necessary to assemble or procure a complete and true list of all the housing units in Cambridge, arranged by street address; this list to be available to the City Council no later than November 1, 1972. Some time ago I believe such a listing was prepared by our Planning and Development Department. I have asked Mr. Jack Partridge of that department to check into this matter and appropriately advise me.

I should further advise your Honorable Body that I did meet with Mr. Brode, Mr. Francis Burns, Ron Cohen and Jack Partridge on these several areas. We have agreed to continue meeting until the various issues have been resolved or otherwise satisfied.
