MAYOR DANEHY

- WHEREAS: The pending gas shortage will severely decrease opportunities for Cambridge residents to leave the city for recreational activities; and
- WHEREAS: There are two recreational areas located a short distance from Cambridge that are under the jurisdiction of the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge Water Board is hereby requested to allow fishing at the Hobbs Brook Reservoir and the Stony Brook Reservoir; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk will be authorized to issue permits to fish at those two areas to Cambridge residents only who possess a Massachusetts fishing license; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this shall be a trial program for one year.
