In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 15, 1868,

Whereas not only the sidewalk, but a considerable portion of the street is greatly and unnecessarily obstructed by the encroaching of Charles on the establishment of James Hancock on Main Street, near West Boston Bridge, delaying the travel for a long time, to the great inconvenience of the public:-

Ordered, That the Chief of Police be instructed to prevent or remove any such obstruction in the future, and, if it cannot otherwise be prevented, to prosecute for all such obstructions.
