- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Alphonso Carbone, a life long Cantabrigian and retired Capital Police Officer; and
- WHEREAS: Alphonso was born in Cambridge, attended local schools and in 1926 joined the United States Marine Corps, rising to the rank of Technical Sergeant, prior to his retirement from the Corps in 1947, having served with the late Admiral Richard E. Byrd's fifty-five man expedition to the South Pole from 1933 to 1935; and
- WHEREAS: Al was presented with the Navy Cross by the late President Franklin D. Roosevelt and was the recipient of the Distinguished Service Medal from Congress for his role in the South Pole expedition; and
- WHEREAS: Al served as a member of the First Marine Division that fought at Guadalcanal during World War II, retiring from the Marines in 1947; and
- WHEREAS: Al, upon his retirement was appointed to the Capital Police Force and served a succession of governors from his State House assignment during his seventeen year career; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Mildred (Siery) Carbone and the Carbone family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Carbone on behalf of the entire City Council.
