(Order to Construct Main Drain or Common Sewers,
General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, Chapter 83)

IN CITY COUNCIL

May 3, 1948.

WHEREAS:-

It is hereby adjudged necessary for the public convenience and the public health that a main drain or common sewer should be laid out, made, constructed and maintained in certain public ways as follows:-

Bent Street, from Ninth Street to Sixth Street

and it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the said main drain or common sewer be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and the Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and instructed to cause the said main drain or common sewer to be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and to report to this City Council after the completion of the work, the cost thereof and assessments shall be made as provided by law upon the abutting estates as follows:-
