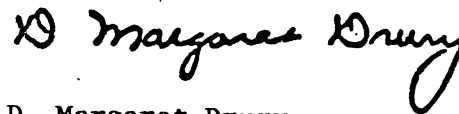

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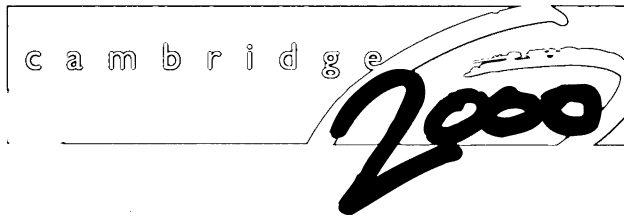

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$70,000 from the Public Works Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Public Works Extraordinary Expenditures Account for the purchase of two pieces of equipment.

The first purchase is for a backhoe for the Cemetery, which is used for the digging and back filling at the Cemetery. The current backhoe is 12 years old.

The second purchase is for a Toro Dingo, which will allow the Parks and Urban Forestry Division to continue to facilitate the City-wide beautification plantings in parks and traffic islands. This will also give the Division the ability to install and repair irrigation and drainage lines that are presently out to bid. Additionally, Public Works will be able to install drainage at numerous sport fields and parks where water accumulates.
