IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Myerson Tooth Corporation for the erection of a banner at 90 Hamilton Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts commencing November 2, 1981 to December 1, 1981.

Said banner to be four feet by six feet, weighing approximately ten to fifteen pounds, to extend over the public way at a height of twelve to fifteen feet.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.

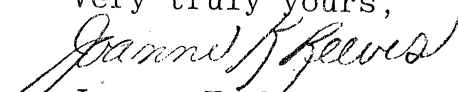

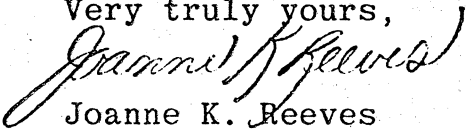

Dear Mr. Healy:

With reference to our telephone conversation today, I appreciate that the Council has granted a permit to Myerson Tooth Corporation authorizing the erection of a banner at 90 Hamilton Street, commencing November 2nd through December 1st.

I have reviewed the conditions of the permit with Company Officials, and it is their feeling that the cost of making the flag and erecting a pole (approximately \$500.00) is such that it would not be worth the investment for a period of one month as stipulated.

In view of this, I request that the Council grant a permit for an indefinite period of time. If this is not possible, a period not less than one year would be satisfactory.

I have enclosed a copy of the original petition and supporting documents. The details are as follows:

DIMENSIONS: The banner/flag will be 4 ft. x 6 ft.
(Similar to a sign)

LOCATION: The banner/flag will hang from a pole leading out from the front of our building at a point above the second floor level. IT WILL NOT HANG ACROSS THE STREET.

DURATION: Indefinitely, or for a period not less than one year.

Basically, the intent is that the banner/flag look similar to a sign that any business or organization may hang outside of its facility.
