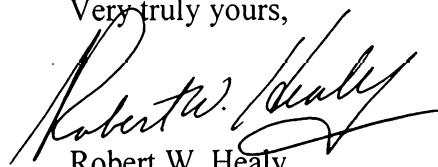

Re: Shuttle Study – Upcoming Travel Needs Assessment Meetings

As part of the ongoing shuttle study that the Community Development Department has undertaken, we are planning a series of public meetings to assess the city's travel needs. By holding multiple meetings at different locations, we hope to solicit input from a diverse group of citizens. These meetings will be publicized through meeting notices in the paper, mailings to citizens, contact with neighborhood groups, and the City's Web site. The information gathered at these meetings will be used to determine the need for additional transportation services in Cambridge. The meetings will take place at the following locations and times:

- **June 8 – 6:00pm: Citywide Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue**
- **June 21 – 6:00pm: North Cambridge Senior Center, 2050 Massachusetts Avenue**
- **June 28 – 6:00pm: East End House, 105 Spring Street**

The shuttle study is proceeding in two stages, the first assessing broad travel needs within the city and the second analyzing potential service improvements in greater detail. By the end of the study, we hope to be able to make recommendations regarding the need for improved transportation services, including both shuttles and public transit.
