EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 7, 2000

In the event of a
DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCY

East Cambridge Residents ONLY may park free of charge in the CambridgeSide Galleria Garage from up to 2 hours prior to the Snow Emergency until 10am the following day after the Snow Emergency has been lifted, regardless of how long it stays in effect.

East Cambridge Residents should enter the Lower Parking Garage on First Street and proceed down to Level C which is the designated area for East Cambridge Residents.

When leaving the garage during or after a Snow Emergency, East Cambridge Residents must only provide proof of residency either in the form of a driver's license or registration, at the Garage Exit Booth. You may then leave without paying, as our guest.

CambridgeSide Galleria hopes that this will allow a faster, more effective street clean-up for you, our neighbors, and give you a safe place to park during the storm.
