I respectfully request the order of the City Council of August 18, 1925 for edgestone on Magoun Street be revoked in so far as it applies to Block Plan 188, Lot No. 79-John J. and Mary A. Doran. This order was in error, because it was a duplication of the order of April 8, 1919. The work was done the same year and was assessed December 8, 1919. The bill was apportioned and the final payment made October 30, 1922.

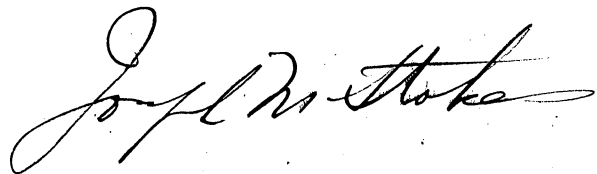
