Petition of the Transit Department of the City of Boston for approval of plan and estimates of cost for the extension of the East Boston Tunnel from Maverick Square to Orient Heights, East Boston, as required by section 5 of Chapter 692 of the Acts of 1945, as amended by Chapter 494 of the Acts of 1946, said section 5 reading as follows:

"No construction work shall be done under this act unless and until a plan therefor, together with estimates of cost indicating that the project can be completed at a cost not exceeding \$8,500,000, shall be approved by the commission of the Department of Public Utilities . . ."

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Wednesday, February 5, 1947, at 10:30 o'clock in the forenoon.
