EVENT/CELLULAR COMMUNICATIONS, INC./SHARED TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

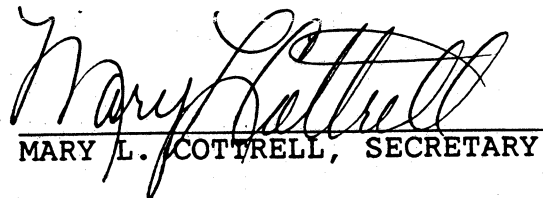
Event Cellular Communications, Inc. ("ECC") and Shared Technologies Inc. ("STI") have filed a joint petition requesting approval by the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") for the transfer of the certificate of public convenience and necessity held by ECC to STI, pursuant to 220 C.M.R. 35.08. ECC is authorized to provide cellular radio telephone services in Massachusetts.

STI has agreed to purchase all of the stock of ECC and to operate ECC as a wholly-owned subsidiary of STI. The transferee intends to operate in Massachusetts under ECC's current tariff on file with the Department, M.D.P.U. Tariff No. 1.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed transfer must be made in writing and filed with the Department on or before September 3, 1991.

The petitioners, Event Cellular Communications, Inc. and Shares Technologies, Inc. are required to give notice of said application by publication hereof once, no later than August 22, 1991 in the Boston Globe, the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield), the Springfield Union News and the Worcester Telegram, and to the parties on the attached list.
