AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to the Cambridge Building Code

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

The Cambridge Building Code, Chapter 5 of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, is hereby amended by adding to Article 6 of said Code the following section:

Section 614.45. Door locks, releases, intercoms.

All hotel buildings, lodging houses, boarding houses, dormitory buildings, and all multiple-family dwelling units having more than two dwelling units (Use groups L-1 and L-2), including all public housing having more than two units, shall have:

- A) all exit doors so designed or equipped as to close and lock automatically with a lock of a type approved by the board of standards in the department of public safety.
- B) a means of electrically releasing the door strike of the main entrance door of the building from each apartment.
- C) a fully operative inter-communication system between the main entrance of the building and each apartment. Such system shall make the voice of the tenant audible at a distance of six feet from the system at the entrance without requiring any action from the person at the entrance.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
