- WHEREAS: Although he fled the scene, all three officers immediately gave chase on foot and they apprehended him at the corner of Prospect and Harvard Streets within minutes; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur (Butchy) Doe, a convicted felon, has previously been charged with operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol and drugs and leaving the scene of an accident as well as being a reported bank robber and is a suspect in at least three unsolved murders in Boston; now therefore be it
